

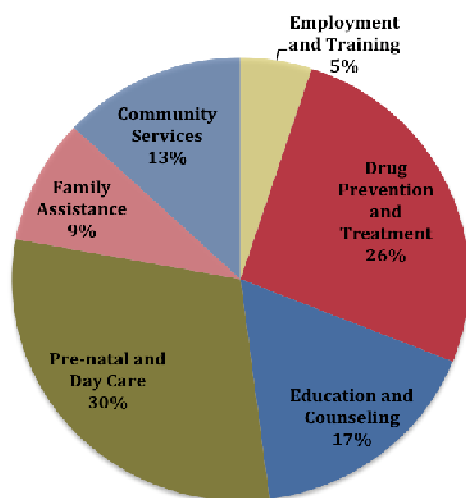
Let's honor the city where **dreams** reach higher than skyscrapers.

- Alianza responds to a full spectrum of community needs: health and mental health; youth training, education and employment; advocacy and community mobilization; and much more.
- It is the most comprehensive Dominican/Latino community development agency in the United States.
- Alianza is the leading authority on Dominican-Americans, the second-largest Latino community in New York State. With:
 - 15 different sites in Northern Manhattan & the West Bronx, and
 - a budget of over \$10 million
- Alianza services more than 60,000 individuals citywide annually

What it takes: The costs to provide quality services continue to increase, yet Alianza is committed to meeting this need.

What your dollars can buy

\$50,000

- Will cover an entire at-risk family for four years from pre-natal care through pre-school with nutritional, educational, and parental support.

\$25,000

- Will provide 65 students per semester with educational assistance including SAT workshops, college visits, tutoring and financial aid advice for parents

\$15,000

- Will support for two years 15 seniors in the Senior Advocacy program where they will be integrated into community life and trained as volunteer advocates and role models for adolescents.

Alianza's Core Strength

- A talented, dedicated staff of over 250—allows us to provide support while we grow and expand our holistic community development activities.
- We extend beyond our Dominican community, throughout New York City, and by model, to other communities throughout the U.S.
